

Tire Disposal Resources

A recurring concern for residents of McKean County, businesses and municipalities is immediate and efficient tire disposal. Collection, storage, labor and transportation costs for disposal as well as illegally dumped tires on private, business and public property have been mentioned as concerns. The following resources might prove to “simplify” your tire disposal concerns and provide options tailored to your needs. These tire resources are registered with the DEP in the state of Pennsylvania for tire collection and hauling to processors and will dispose of your tires in a responsible manner. Depending upon the option chosen, costs per tire would vary and would have to be negotiated. Tire disposal options, depending upon the firm and quantities of tires include: arranging to make a stop at property, business or municipal building, (for municipal spring and fall “clean ups”, “setting up” a trailer if the municipality expects a large number of tires or partnering with a service station for collections and setting up selected days when residents could bring their tires to the service station.

Please be aware that there are “tire collectors” in the area who are taking tires for a small fee and illegally dumping them so be sure to question disposal destinations.
