RESIDENT DISABLED VETERAN LIFETIME LICENSE APPLICATION

Please note, Resident Disabled Veteran Lifetime licenses and yearly renewals are available through County Treasurer offices only. To qualify, an applicant must be a resident disabled veteran of any war or armed conflict whose disability consists of the loss of one or more limbs, the loss of use of one or more limbs, or who presents a physician's certificate of total or 100% disability. For Disabled Veteran Lifetime License, applicant must present documentation that the condition/s is permanent. (Refer to reverse side for additional information)

Applicant: Check type of license desired

Treasurer: Enter license/back tag numbers issued in spaces provided
Issue Adult Resident Hunting and/or Furtaker license regardless of age.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION ON RESIDENT DISABLED VETERANS LIFETIME LICENSES

APPLICANTS - IDENTIFICATION CARDS AND YEARLY RENEWAL LICENSES:

In June, following the issuance of a Resident Disabled Veteran Lifetime License, you will receive an identification card issued by the Game Commission. This identification card is needed to obtain the required renewal license each year. Renewal licenses are available through County Treasurers only. To obtain a renewal license, license holder must produce his or her identification issued by the Game Commission, along with their valid Pennsylvania driver's license or some other form or positive identification showing current address.

If you change your address, please notify the License Division at (717) 787-2084 immediately. We will issue a new identification card showing your new address. If you move out-of-state, you are not eligible to renew your lifetime license.

COUNTY TREASURERS - ISSUING YEARLY RENEWAL LICENSES:

Resident Disabled Veteran Lifetime Licenses and renewal licenses are issued by County Treasurers only. There is no specific license printed for Resident Disabled Veteran Lifetime Licenses or renewal licenses. Issue a free Adult Resident Hunting and/or Adult Resident Furtaker license to qualified applicants regardless of age. You may deduct \$1 from your monthly report for each Resident Disabled Veteran Lifetime Hunting, Resident Disabled Veteran Lifetime Furtaker, or yearly renewal license issued.
