FACT SHEET ON RESIDENT SENIOR LIFETIME LICENSES:

SENIOR LIFETIME HUNTING, FURTKAKER AND COMBINATION

WHO QUALIFIES? Pennsylvania residents 65 years of age or older, or who will be 65 by June 30 of the current license year, may qualify for a resident senior lifetime hunting, resident senior lifetime furtaker or resident senior lifetime combination license. To qualify, applicants must have held a prior hunting and/or furtaker license or have successfully completed a Hunter-Trapper Education course.

COMBINATION LICENSES: Combination licenses include hunting, furtaker, archery and muzzleloader privileges - no additional stamps or tags are required to cover these privileges. A combination license does not include bear license, migratory game bird license or antlerless deer license privileges. These licenses must be applied for separately each year if desired. Senior lifetime hunting and senior lifetime furtaker license holders have the option of upgrading to a combination license at the reduced cost of \$51.

WHERE CAN THEY BE PURCHASED? Pennsylvania Game Commission's Harrisburg Headquarters, 2001 Elmerton Avenue, Harrisburg, PA 17110-9797 or any of our six (6) Regional Offices located throughout the state. You may apply on-line at www.pgc.state.pa.us.

DOCUMENTATION NEEDED: Applicants must produce documentation to prove their age and residency via (1) valid Pennsylvania driver's license or (2) current local or state personal income tax receipts and some other form of positive identification proving their age. All mail orders must include copies of this documentation with the application and remittance.

Social security numbers are used to electronically file license holder information in our computerized database of lifetime license holders. All information is kept completely confidential.

RENEWAL LICENSES: New lifetime hunting and combination license holders receive an ID card in June following issuance of the license. To obtain a yearly renewal license, lifetime license holders may apply on-line or at any authorized in-state issuing agent. License holders must show their ID card and valid Pennsylvania driver's license or some other form of positive identification documenting their current residency. The agent then issues a renewal license (new general hunting license back tag and renewal stamp) at no charge. Renewal licenses are the same for both regular hunting and combination license categories. The difference is that combination license holders are required to carry their ID card with them at all times while hunting or trapping. Lifetime license holders who move out-of-state cannot lawfully renew their lifetime license.

Individuals who hold resident senior lifetime furtaker licenses only will have their renewal license mailed directly to them each year in June, from the Game Commission's Harrisburg Headquarters. They will not receive an ID card.
