ANNOUNCEMENT: McKean County Juvenile Probation Officer

37.5 hours per week

A Juvenile Probation Officer performs duties and responsibilities consistent with the requirements of the Pennsylvania Juvenile Act, Rules of Juvenile Court Procedure, Principles of Balanced and Restorative Justice, and Juvenile Justice Evidence-Based Practices. The mission and purpose of the Juvenile Act mandates that youth who commit delinquent acts be provided "programs of supervision, care and rehabilitation which provide balanced attention to the protection of the community, the imposition of accountability for offenses committed and the development of competencies to enable children to become responsible and productive members of the community."

A Juvenile Probation Officer is responsible for enforcing Court orders and assuring offenders compliance with conditions of supervision, diversionary program participation and aftercare, while at all times protecting public safety. A Juvenile Probation Officer is responsible for employing evidenced-based practices which may include assessments, interventions, and treatment approaches that have been demonstrated by sound research to work most effectively to reduce recidivism with juvenile offenders. Supervision of offenders will occur in the school, home and community settings and at times will require non-traditional work hours (nights and weekends), travel and on-call responsibilities. Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university required with transcript verification. Successful completion of New Probation Officer Orientation classes will be required during probationary period. Must complete forty (40) hours of training annually. Must hold a valid driver's license and prior to employment must provide clean criminal record and child abuse clearances.
